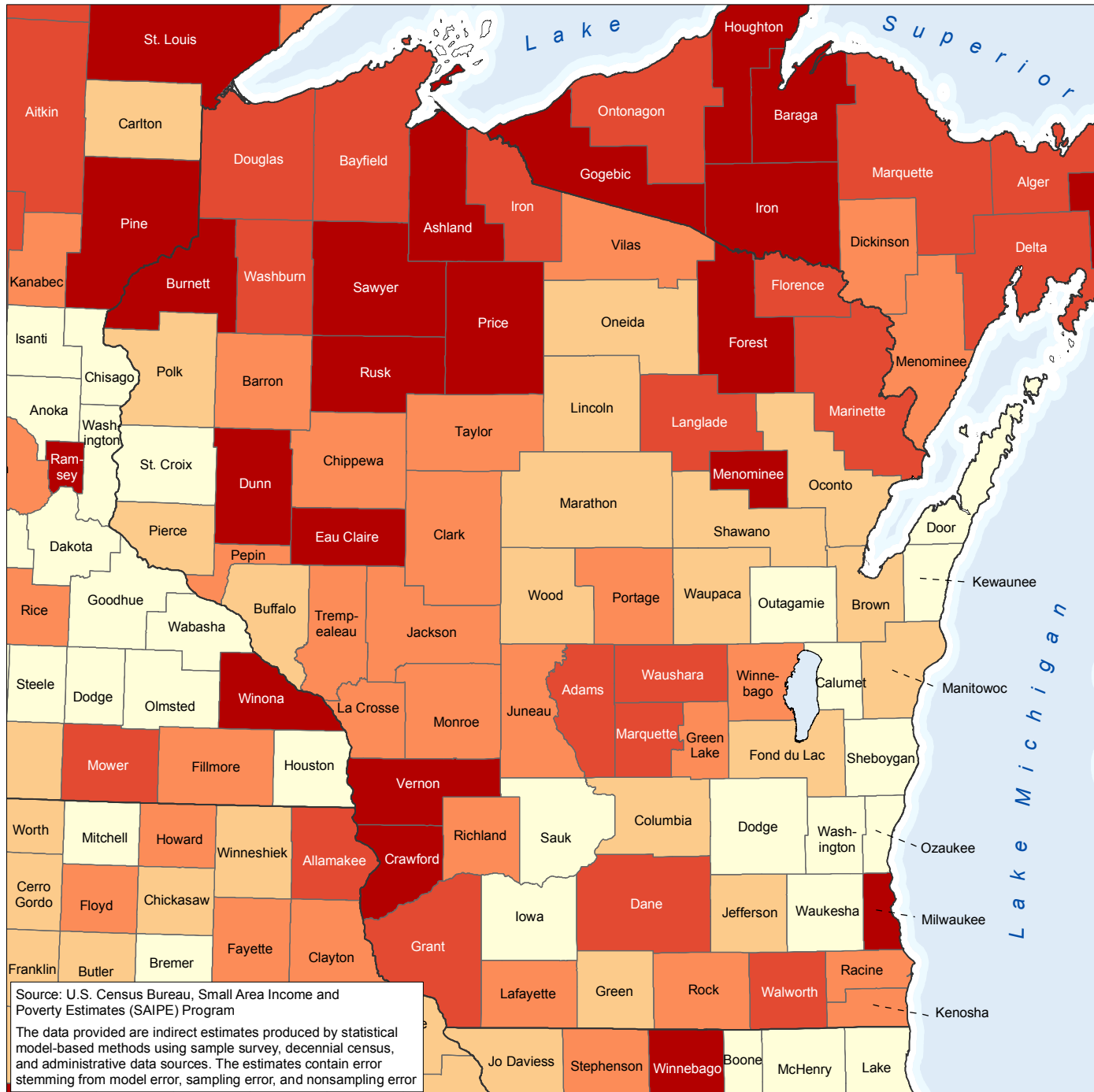
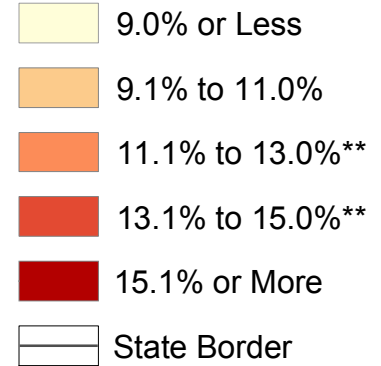


Poverty Rates by County in 2009 - Percent of Population in Poverty

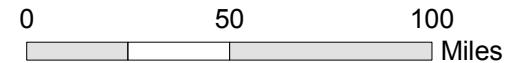


Percent of Population in Poverty (2009)*
